I thought this was an appropriate title but I did add the “II” to it. I am concluding this era of responsibility, as my duties as Vice Chairperson of our Carolinas NCRS Chapter is coming to an end this month. I have enjoyed this position immensely, and will continue to be a member in good standing, with little else changing from my perspective. I also have an additional *End of an Era* that is touched on below.

With this change comes new blood to the organization, something I believe in wholeheartedly – your newly elected VC-to-be will indeed bring about some new activities, new ideas to be incorporated within our membership, and overall, a positive and new direction for our Chapter. Our *lifetime* Chairperson Jimmy Gregg deserves this!

I do wish to thank all of you that supported me during this rewarding term of leadership, but sometimes I feel as though I have left out something, perhaps not contributed more where I should have...in short, this is the time for the *End of an Era* on my part – let’s “git-er-done” as they say! Now is the time for YOU to sort through our very capable membership and select the person you feel is most capable for this position – don’t wait until our general membership meeting to start thinking about this very important task! I can think of several folks that would slip into this position very easily...so can you!

Hmmmm..... *The End of an Era* can also be applied to my most recent (and seemingly ever-ongoing) work on my project car; I can now use that term loosely as it is all but completed. Some of you are very tuned into what I have been working on in the shop for the past three years, others are not. Unfortunately it is not a straight-axle Corvette that has been nagging at me for the past few years – seems that thought is just wishful thinking. However, it does have a straight axle if that is any advantage (Ford 9” to be exact!). My 1964 Ford Fairlane Thunderbolt Recreation is history regarding the project stage, and currently residing at my 427-minded friend and super-tuner for those last minute details, like tuning those Holley 2-4 bbls that I am not that keen on doing myself. His expertise is unsurpassed in the Ford 427 world and I did not have an issue on passing the buck to him for that detail. I should get the car back within the week, then off to the alignment shop, the final task on the hit list.

So, what is the deal on this car? Memory does not serve me well regarding my thought process that directed me into this project, but I do know that initially I had envisioned a different car than I now have. Typically, most folks believe the real Thunderbolts are white in color again, I use that term “typically” loosely, as the very first 11 cars were actually special-ordered *maroon* (Vintage Burgundy) Fairlane 500 2-door sedans. These first-series cars were pulled directly off the assembly line as showroom ready cars; they all had bench seats, Hi-Po 289/4 speeds with radio-heater and sound deadening deletes and were sent as a group to a small company Ford used to build specialty vehicles called Dearborn Steel Tubing (DST). DST had built several one-off vehicles for Ford over the years but this was their biggest challenge to date—build 100 special drag cars, with the goal of having the best and fastest car available. The remaining 89 cars were all white, pulled from the Ford assembly line as partial cars, lacking front sheet metal, engine, transmission, and front seats (also more deletes, but those are the major ones).

Here is where my thought process changed – build a *recreation* of one of those early cars! It was a major task, requiring hours upon hours of research, traveling to sites that had original Thunderbolts on display, and taking hundreds of pictures for future reference. My travels and documentation of these very special cars proved to be elusive for reference purposes for the most part as these once-original cars have since been modified, most likely starting with day one at the hands of selected drag racers, whose names most old timers readily recall. Since I could not find a true original example of an early car, I resorted to collecting old magazine articles that highlighted the release of Ford’s newest threat to the drag strips – the pictures and articles were actually a huge help to me, sort of like re-visiting these cars via a time machine.

Long story short, and do not want to bore you with details, this car I just completed is a *very accurate duplication* of the first few of these strip-terrors that dominated the drag racing circuit in 1964. It is, for the most part, a mirror image of a forgotten time – a picture of my car from any angle, especially if in black and white, will duplicate any of those early magazine pictures I used for initial references. I even went to the extreme of reproducing the original (and butt-ugly!) Clover Leaf Hood Scoop that has long-since disappeared, replaced by the now-infamous Tear Drop Hood Scoop. Of course I used my Corvette related fiberglass expertise to accomplish this task! Yes, I am anal about details remember, I have been into Corvette rebuilding and restoration since 1963; now, if I could only find that project '57!

My fruits of labor were rewarded last month when I debuted the car at the Z-Max Dragway's car show, sponsored by two well-known Ford clubs. The car was well accepted, and although the intent was not to enter the event for trophies, I managed to walk away with three, including Best Muscle Car. Also rewarding was the rumor that there was a real Thunderbolt in the show field – I did of course dispel that rumor during the many visits by the curious! I also met several Ford fans that I have added to my email list for future communications....like the Corvette world, the Ford world also has those true-blue diehard enthusiasts that become friends, the backbone of this car orientated land of plenty. I seem to thrive when my lips are moving in car-land!

In closing, I wish to thank you all for bearing with me on my past contributions to this newsletter – it has been fun, and for those that have followed some, or most, of these articles, you know that I do not always present information relating to Corvettes....maybe I should have, but most of the articles within the Newsletter fill that bill. I have attempted to present another view in the car world, realizing that many of our Chapter members are actually owners of "other brands" of cars. It is you folks that provide me with the escape from the Corvette-dom dominated articles – thanks for bearing with me and putting up with my ramblings! I wish again to thank those who helped me in this position; for me, this is indeed a doubly so "End of an Era."
